Holocaust Education Networking Hub Unpacking the Holocaust

A FREE full day delivered by University College London (UCL), introduces the key issues in Holocaust education and is relevant to all teachers including the following interactive workshops:

- Who were the 6 million?
- What was the Holocaust? An interactive timeline
- Being human?

The workshops explore the vibrancy and diversity of European Jewish communities on the eve of the Holocaust and the development of the European culture of antisemitism.

Using details about Nazi decrees alongside personal stories of the victims, examine the impact of state policy on real men, women and children, creating a compelling interactive timeline that interweaves the narratives of multiple victim groups.

Finally, uncover how and why ordinary people became complicit in mass murder, posing searching questions about what it is to be a citizen in the modern world.
