Workshops will be led by Louise, Simon and Trevor from Challenging Education and Special Guest Georgina Burt, Development Manager for Child Poverty Action Group.

These will centre around how schools achieve equity

- through high expectations
- through planning at all levels
- through curriculum delivery
- by broadening participation

Each workshop will involve examples from secondary and primary phases as well as the opportunity to network as you work ideas through for your context.


The Challenging Education team have some great news to share about our work going forward. Teaser – you could be the first to hear about project grants available to schools!


