



Are You Sitting Comfortably...

Smart Start is the Warwickshire initiative to improve outcomes for children, increasing the numbers of children who achieve Good Levels of Development at the end of the EYFS. More information can be found on the Smart Start web pages. http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/smartstart

At Universal Level every setting offering provision to children aged 0-5 will be able to access 2 free training sessions, to include:

Reception classes, Nursery classes, Pre-schools, Day Nurseries, Child minders, Out of School Clubs

Session 1 – Sitting for Learning- Morning session

Good sitting allows children to concentrate, communicate, interact, develop fine motor skills and learn. The first session will look at how to recognise good sitting skills, how to support children's development and how to support those children who need additional intervention.

Session2 – Sitting for Personal Care- Afternoon session

Children will need to be able to sit securely so that they can develop independent toileting and personal care skills. The session will look at how to support children in sitting and also the wider skills needed to develop independence in toileting, including communication skills managing anxiety and supporting medical needs.
