



Free KS3/KS4 MFL (French, German, Spanish and Mandarin)

Teacher Subject Specialism Training

We are offering a fantastic opportunity for non-specialist KS3/KS4 MFL teachers to attend a fully-funded Teacher Subject Specialism Training (TSST) course in Modern Foreign Languages offered by Birmingham City University in conjunction with Lawrence Sheriff School.

This training is delivered **free of cost** to participants. This includes:

- non-specialist teachers who could potentially teach a relevant subject in addition to their main subject
- non-specialist teachers who are currently teaching a relevant subject either full-time or in addition to their specialist subject
- teachers looking to return to the profession
- language specialists who aren't currently teaching MFL
- language specialists who could potentially teach an additional language

The purpose of this training is to improve the subject knowledge of non-specialist and returning teachers. It will increase the number of hours taught by offering school-led teacher subject specialism training opportunities.

The majority of courses on offer involve training during term time. If you're a serving teacher and would like to take part, you should discuss this with your school before making contact with Birmingham City University.

We have a limited number of places, so please register your interest as soon as possible. The programme will begin in October 2016. You do not have to currently be teaching MFL to be applicable.
