Follow simple instructions we can provide and make and decorate your own tree to be on display with others at All Saints for the beginning of December 2017. Tree's of Intent (or A4 photo's of your tree) need to be at All Saints Church by Thursday 24th November, 2017 to be included for display.

What to knit?

Instructions for knitting a 10 inch square:

- Use double knit (DK) green yarn (any shade) on 4mm needles.
- Cast on 40 stitches.
- Garter stitch only (all rows) until work measures 10 inches (approx 70 rows). Cast off.

Instructions for more experienced knitters:

- Knit (or crochet) Christmas tree decorations – all shapes and sizes.
- Not too small, and no bigger than 10 inches tall.

Ideas for younger people:

- Knit smaller squares and make different coloured pom-poms as baubles.

Final deadline for collection: Friday 26th October 2018.
