#### Safeguarding Records Single Central Record and other Processes

Just a reminder to plan and arrange transfer of safeguarding files to their new destinations. We encourage you to make sure safeguarding records only go to a DSL and that you have an itemised receipt signed by the destination school. We have attached two templates which you are welcome to adapt and use for this process.

Similarly, please remind admin staff to chase records from previous schools and if you are concerned, please follow it up. The same applies to online records.

Some staff will be moving on, so please **make sure you have enough staff trained as DSLs and Early Help lead professionals** and please work with admin and school business managers to ensure HR files (references etc) and the SCR is updated over the summer. #### Publication of the NEW Keeping Children Safe in Education (KCSiE) DfE 2022

The Department for Education (DfE) has published an updated version of its statutory KCSiE for schools in England, which will come into force on 1st September 2022. Annex F of the of the new guidance sets out the changes made, including: a new paragraph on domestic abuse added to the list of safeguarding issues all staff should be aware of, new information on the importance of schools talking to parents about children's access to online sites when away from school, and a new paragraph highlighting the importance of ensuring that children understand the law on child-on-child abuse is there to protect them rather than criminalise them. We will be publishing updates for schools to update staff prior to the summer break.

## SELF HARM

As part of the work programme of the Warwickshire Self Harm Working Group, an audit was undertaken with Warwickshire schools in the summer term of 2021 to better understand the selfharm challenges being experienced. A recommendation from this exercise was to develop a template Self Harm Policy that schools could adopt either as part of their existing safeguarding processes or to use as a standalone document to support specific self-harm challenges.

To help us develop a resource that is of most use to you and your school community, we are proposing to run a series of focus groups to enable schools/education settings in Warwickshire to input into the development of this document and ensure that we cover the information and support needs requested by schools.

In preparation for this we are inviting schools to express an interest in taking part of these focus groups – and to help us shape how, when and where these are delivered. Please complete this form (by Friday 22 July 2022) to let us know if you would like to be involved.

An initial first draft of the Self Harm Policy will be shared with participating schools in advance of the focus groups.
