

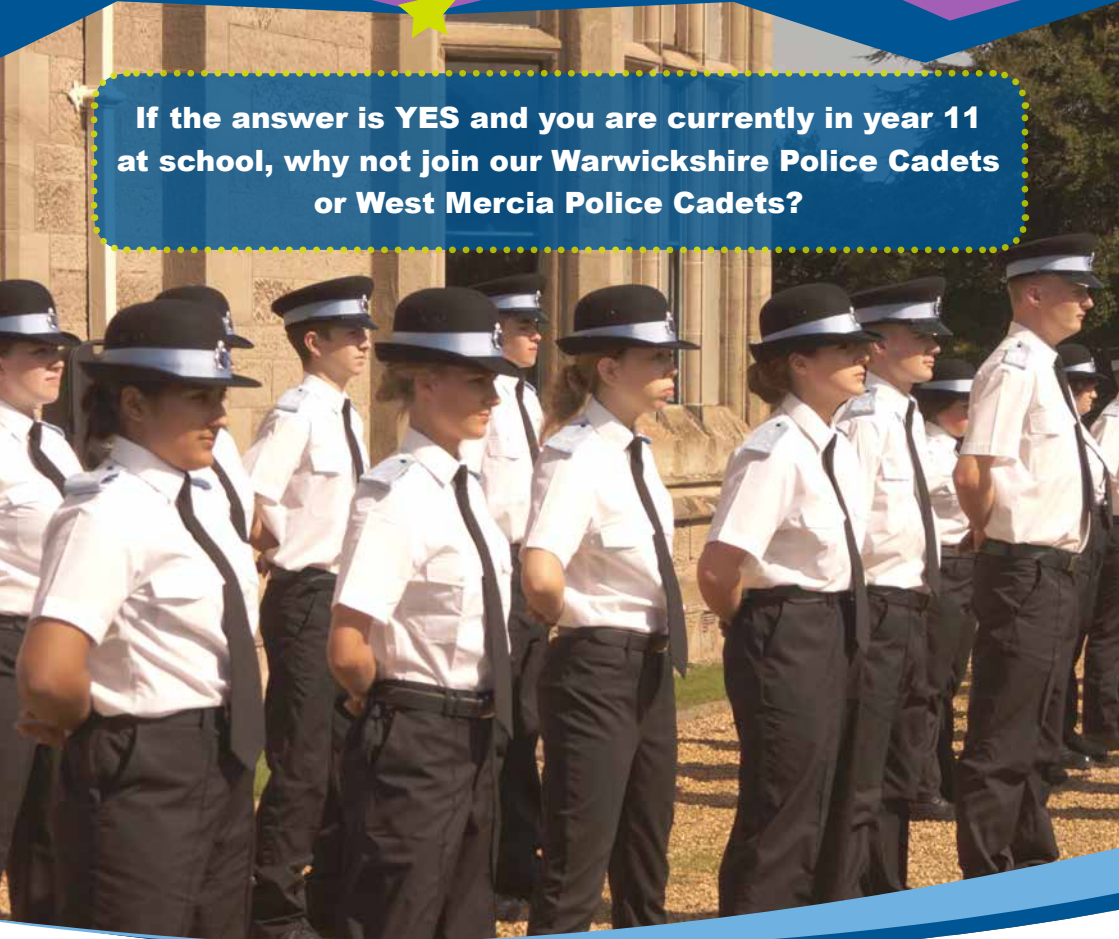

Warwickshire Police Cadets and West Mercia Police Cadets are a volunteer scheme for young people available in Herefordshire, Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin, Warwickshire and Worcestershire.

The scheme is aimed at 16-18 year olds who want to gain a practical understanding of policing, as well as develop their spirit of adventure and good citizenship.

Cadets support local policing priorities through volunteering, working with partner agencies and positive participation in their communities.

During the two year programme cadets undertake a variety of activities including team building, fitness, marching, role playing and an outdoor activity week.

They can also gain a Level 2 Award in Leadership & Team Skills awarded by the Institute of Leadership & Management (ILM).

Cadets can gain an insight into police life through talks by guest speakers from different departments and agencies and by taking part in local community policing events.



Being a police cadet has taught me the value of getting out there and making an effort for other people. Sharing the experience has resulted in me forming some of the strongest friendships I have ever had. Don't shy away from the opportunity to make a real positive impact in somebody's life – you might never realise what a difference you made.
