The theme for SID2020 this year is **Free to be ME!**

We would like you to write about how the way we represent ourselves online can affect the impression that we make on other people. This can be done in the form of a short story, poem, rhyme, song, rap or short play.

There are a few rules (not too many):

1. You may create your entry using any method you choose (video, audio, animation, illustrated short story, script etc)
2. It can be serious or amusing, but the message must be clear and demonstrate good practice.
3. Your entry must be original and clearly labelled, so that we can let your school know if you win!
4. Your school needs to choose the best entry and your teacher needs to email it to the judges as a file (it can be a (clear) scanned image), but the judges must be able to open it. Entries will be accepted from Warwickshire and Coventry Primary/Infant/Junior schools (including previous ICTDS customers from outside this area)

What the Judges are looking for:

The judges will score entries on (entries submitted anonymously to the judges):

- The short story, poem, rhyme, song, rap or short play is on SID2020 message (Free to be ME)
- Sound, online safety advice is given
- Originality

Feedback from the judges will be given to the top three schools

- Judges will include representatives from ICTDS, Smoothwall and Childnet.
- Prize: £100 to support Online Safety within the school, kindly sponsored by Smoothwall
