WRAP is a specialist workshop designed by HM government to provide you with an understanding of the Prevent strategy and your role within it.

Completing this module will give you an introduction to Prevent and help you understand what vulnerabilities may make someone susceptible to radicalisation and all types of extremism. Local safeguarding arrangements will be outlined along with the local Channel Panel referral system and who to contact should you have any concerns. This module is awareness raising to support you in your role.

Individuals who have not had any previous training in Prevent, extremism and radicalisation and work directly with the community, children, young people and their families.

Learning Outcomes

- To understand the Prevent Duty, agenda and your role within it
- To provide you with the ability to use existing expertise and professional judgment to recognise vulnerable individuals who may need support if someone is potentially being radicalised, groomed or is involved in extremism
- To understand how extremism affects individuals
- Identify local safeguarding and referral mechanisms to engage with in order to support those identified as vulnerable to radicalisation or extremism

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
