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Course Information: Managing Behaviour in the Playground

This course will focus on how adults can manage children's behaviour during playtime / lunchtime sessions through the use of assertive behaviour and language strategies. We will identify ways in which mid-day supervisors can develop good relationships with pupils in order to help them gain and keep control whilst on the playground. Delegates will be introduced to a number of games designed to encourage cooperation, sharing and teamwork for use with pupils, to create a more positive playground environment for everyone. This course would suit midday supervisors and support staff who also undertake this role.

This course has been designed to meet the needs of those Midday Supervisors who have a responsibility for organising play activities and supervising primary aged children during wet lunchtimes. The course will be part theory, part practical and will engage delegates in a wide range of activities suitable for indoor spaces/classrooms. We will explore ways in which to organise the space and manage the available resources effectively so that wet lunchtimes run more smoothly! Delegates are asked to come suitably dressed for some gentle activity. This course would suit midday supervisors and support staff who also undertake this role.

This half day course will equip you with the necessary skills, knowledge and understanding to deliver dance successfully as part of your school's physical education curriculum. Throughout the session we will use a variety of different stimuli to look at the basic principles for creating simple dance phrases, exploring dance techniques and choreographic structures. You will be introduced to the dance concepts of performing, composing and appreciating, and experience a range of progressive activities, easily organised to suit both KS1 and KS2 pupils. Delegates should come dressed for practical activity and bring their own refreshments.

Throughout the session delegates will be practically engaged in a wide range of both new and traditional games that encourage cooperation, sharing, teamwork and listening skills. The games will reinforce positive values, in order to help develop relationships and improve playground behaviour. The games will be easy to organise and can be set up by adults or child play leaders. An ideal course for those looking for a fresh range of new ideas.

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Course Information: Teaching Gymnastics Safely at KS1 and KS2

This half day course will equip you with the necessary skills, knowledge and understanding to safely deliver gymnastics as part of your school's physical education curriculum. Throughout the course you will work with pupils from the host school and be introduced to effective organisational principles. You will practise supporting (ie 'hands on') pupils as they perform the progressive steps of learning forward and backward rolls and other gymnastic skills. You will explore the effective use and positioning of apparatus and mats, transition of floor skills onto apparatus, together with key health and safety issues.

Through practical involvement, we will explore a wide range of games and activities using the parachute, that can be played both indoors and outdoors. We will explore cross curricular links and playing for fun. This course would be suitable for teachers, teaching assistants, midday supervisors and adults involved with wrap around care provision.

We will also explore how the development of fundamental movement skills together with multi-skills practices can develop your pupils' ability to play games successfully.
