- Discrimination by perception
- Indirect discrimination
- Discrimination arising from disability
- Duty to make reasonable adjustments for those with disabilities, harassment, and victimisation

We work with a range of individuals, groups and organisations across the private, public, voluntary and community sectors which allows us to build an understanding of the key issues surrounding Equality & Diversity that are pertinent to Warwickshire and its communities.

We also provide a free and confidential, AQS accredited, casework service to anyone who has experienced hate or discrimination, under any of the 9 protected characteristics as defined by the Equality Act 2010: -

- Pregnancy and maternity
- Age
- Disability
- Marriage and civil partnership
- Gender
- Race
- Gender identity
- Religion or belief
- Sexual orientation.

Once a person or organisation gets in touch with us, we carry out an assessment to determine their needs and whether additional support is required from one of our many partner organisations.

Having developed a Hate Crime Charter for Warwickshire, we also offer a free online elearning course that can be accessed via the <u>www.reporthatenow.com</u> website. I am sure you will agree with me that hateful comments and behaviour should never be tolerated and should always be reported. This course is about educating all frontline staff and members on the difference between a hate crime and a hate incident.

As an organisation striving for equality and inclusion it is imperative for the Senco staff in the school learning environment to have their voices heard. We can offer further guidance to your Special Educational Needs Co-ordinators particularly in terms of the stakeholders making reasonable adjustments necessary to support the students. What might be considered 'reasonable' for one organisation might not be the same for another.

The EQuIP team will be able to work in collaboration with Schools, to maintain and support the students with an awareness around culture and the impact it has on families, which can all affect a young person's health and wellbeing too in education.

EQuIP, as an organisation, are here to support and guide you on this journey, we protect your anonymity. Sometimes speaking to someone other than the police can help and EQuIP are here to support you throughout. It is our commitment to continue cultivating an environment in which both staff and students feel accepted, included, and safe.
