## **Glossary of Terms**

CSA	Compulsory School Age – the term after the child's 5 <sup>th</sup> birthday
Delayed Entry	Summer-born children requesting to start school in Reception

	child's start to school for a year, but they do not have the legal
	right to choose which year group they will then be educated in
Deferred Entry	Parent's legal right to decide that their child will not take up
	their school place until the child reaches CSA.
EOYG	Educated out of year group
LA	The Local Authority (e.g. Warwickshire County Council)
Normal age	Child's chronological cohort (i.e. the year group they should be
group	educated in, as defined by their age)
Own AA School	A school that is its own admission authority, e.g. academy,
	voluntary aided, free school, foundation school
Part-time	Parent's legal right to decide that their child will start school on
admission	a part-time basis. Child must be attending full-time by the time
	they reach CSA.
Specialist Panel	The group of professionals who consider all EOYG requests
	for LA maintained schools
Summer-born	A child born between 1 <sup>st</sup> April and 31 <sup>st</sup> August
