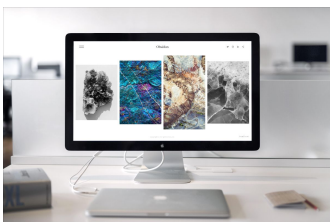

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English Mastery Research

Between this year and 2024, English Mastery is partnering with the Education Endowment Foundation and Sheffield Hallam University to evaluate the efficacy of Ark Curriculum plus' English Mastery programme through a two-year independent randomised controlled trial. From June 2022 to June 2024, 120 schools in the West Midlands, East Midlands and the Humber, and the North (as defined by RSC boundaries) will participate. The trial will assess the impact of English Mastery on student progress in English across Years 7 and 8.
