
Headteachers in the first five years of headship who have, or are completing an NPQH are eligible for a 12-month targeted support programme. Find out more here.

The course is delivered through a blended approach of online learning, virtual workshops and face to face sessions, followed by a 1500-word case study assessment.

Time commitment over 18 months
