STEP 1: What NPQ would you like to do?

Familiarize yourself with their content and suitability in relation to your role and career progression.

STEP 2: What are your funding options?

Scholarship funding eligibility criteria varies for each of the NPQs. It is important that you understand the funding and have approval from your school budget holder. Also support from your school leaders before registering and applying for an NPQ. A summary of the funding options can be viewed here.

Funding Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for **full scholarship funding**, with no cost to the participant, teachers and leaders **must meet all criteria below**:

A. Have, or aspiring to have responsibilities for leading in the NPQ area	✓	✓	✓	✓	✓*	✓

NPQH * meet criteria A, B and C **OR** meet criteria B and are a headteacher or head of school in the first 2 academic years of headship then you also qualify for full scholarship funding.

STEP 3: REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT FOR EDUCATION (DfE)

Teachers themselves should then register on the [DfE's platform](#). Ideally you will **need your Teacher Reference Number (TRN)** and National Insurance Number, but it is possible to register without these and provide them later. There is a handy step-by-step guide to registering with the DfE at the end of this document.



STEP 4: TELL US YOU HAVE REGISTERED (so we can get you set on Ambition's system)

Complete the John Taylor TSHub [Expression of Interest form](#). We will use this information to register you with Ambition, who check your details against your DfE registration. This enables funding access and/or your expression to be formally logged with Ambition. Check your inbox and spam/email quarantine restrictions.



STEP 5: COMPLETE AMBITION INSTITUTE'S FULL APPLICATION FORM

Please complete the application in full as soon as possible. We will review your application and confirm your place on the programme. At this point, you will have access to 'Steplab', Ambition's online training platform, which will provide you with access to the programme materials.

Teacher reference number

Your teacher reference number (TRN) is used to check you're eligible to study for a national professional qualification (NPQ).

The service will ask if you know your **Teacher Reference Number (TRN)**.

If you have this at hand, choose 'yes'. You can progress without it, but you will need to confirm it at a later date to validate your application.

Name changes

Your name must match the name held in the Teaching Regulation Agency records to confirm you can take an NPQ.

Has your name changed since you became a qualified teacher?

You will be asked if you have changed your name, as this is the most common reason someone's details cannot be matched against their TRN so collecting previous names will help alleviate this issue.

Check your details

We need to check your details on the Teaching Regulation Agency records to ensure you qualify to study for a National Professional Qualification (NPQ).

Teacher reference number (TRN)
Your TRN is 7-10 characters long. It may begin with "RP"

Full name
Your full name exactly as it appears on the Teaching Regulation Agency records

Date of birth
For example, 12 11 1990

Day Month Year

National Insurance Number (optional)
This will help us match your details

You will be asked to provide details so the DfE can validate you. This check is done against the database of qualified teachers.

It may say your details are not recognized – this happened when we tried

- Do not add the / in your TRN
- Do not add titles prefixing your name (e.g. Mr, Mrs, Miss, Ms, Mx, Dr)
- Enter your name exactly as it appears on your TRN document/certificate

Contact us if you are having any issues!

We cannot find your details

We cannot find a match with the details you have provided.

This could be because:

- you have abbreviated your first name, for example Rob/Robert
- your surname is different to the name held on the Teaching Regulation Agency records
- you've entered an incorrect TRN
- you have entered an incorrect date of birth
