

## **Workshop to Raise Awareness of Prevent 3 (WRAP3)** **Train the Trainer for use with school staff**

**WRAP 3 is a new online version of the original WRAP programme.**

**Many Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSLs) previously attended a Train the Trainer course delivered by Police Prevent officers in order to deliver the original WRAP programme to school staff.**

**These workshops are now being provided to support Designated Safeguarding Leads to use the new online WRAP 3 programme with groups of staff to ensure staff are appropriately trained and informed about the Prevent agenda.**

### **Programme Brief**

This half-day WRAP 3 Train the Trainer course will enable DSLs to deliver the Workshop to Raise Awareness on Prevent 3 (WRAP 3) programme to school staff.

The workshop will provide an update on the Prevent strategy and a recap of the individual's role in safeguarding vulnerable people in relation to issues of radicalisation and extremism.

This course is based on a **new** Home Office online training tool which DSLs can use as the basis of Prevent training in schools.

Completing this module will give you the skills to deliver WRAP3 online training.

### **Target Group**

- Individuals who have not had any previous training in delivering training to staff about Prevent, extremism and radicalisation; and are now responsible for ensuring that new staff receive that training as part of their safeguarding induction and as part of regular update safeguarding training.
- Those who may have attended a WRAP Train the Trainer course in the past who would like refresher training on Prevent/WRAP.
- Individuals who would like to deliver their Prevent training using an online tool rather than the previous combined PowerPoint presentation and Home Office script.

## **Learning Outcomes**

At the end of the course delegates will:

- have the skills and knowledge to deliver Prevent training to groups of staff as part of their wider safeguarding training, using the online WRAP 3 training tool
- have an updated understanding of the Prevent Duty and agenda
- be aware of who may be vulnerable to all types of extremism
- be able to identify the signs of why some people are vulnerable to being influenced and manipulated into extremism
- be clear on what help and support is available in Warwickshire and who they should turn to if they have concerns
