The SCERTS model is a comprehensive, multidisciplinary educational approach designed for children with Autism. It provides a framework for those who are implementing a comprehensive educational plan helping children progress through the stages of becoming a competent social communicator. Participants of this course will learn how to determine meaningful, purposeful and motivating goals and strategies based on a child's developmental stage, functional needs and family priorities.
