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## Changes to AB Services

Appropriate Body (AB) services are changing:

- From September 2023 schools must use a TSH AB for all new ECT registrations.
- From September 2023 Local Authorities will be unable to register new ECTs. They will cease operating as ABs from September 2024. This two-stage withdrawal for LAs from AB services will allow the majority of ECTs who began induction in September 2022 to complete their induction without needing to transfer to a new AB.
- From September 2024 Teaching School Hubs (TSHs) will be the sole provider of AB services.

We are working closely with Warwickshire LA and Coventry City Council to ensure that the transition is as seamless as possible. You will be reassured to know that we are using the ECT Manager platform that you are familiar with to manage the service, so the administration for

you will remain the same as you have used.


