From September 2021, the Early Career Framework (ECF) reforms will entitle all early career teachers to a funded two-year package of structured training and support linked to the best available research evidence.

Coventry and Central Warwickshire Teaching School Hub have partnered with University College London (UCL) to offer the full induction programme. UCL is one of six providers accredited by the DfE, to deliver an excellent programme of both online and face-to-face training for early careers teachers (ECTs) and their mentors.



NPQs

We are delighted to be also working in conjunction with UCL to deliver the full suite of newly reformed National Professional Qualifications. We offer three courses designed for leaders: NPQH (Headship), NPQSL (Senior Leaders), NPQEYL (Early Years Leadership). We also offer all four of the Specialist qualifications: NPQLT (Leading Teaching), NPQLTD (Leading Teacher Development), NPQLBC (Leading Behaviour and Culture) and NPQLL (Leading Literacy).

Our NPQ courses offer participants a blended learning experience; experienced, expert facilitators run all our face-to-face sessions locally.


