Specialist Leader of Education Role

Are you a fully qualified teacher with a passion for making a difference in the Early Years and at least 5 years experience in an EY role? (including 2 years experience leading an aspect of the EY or Foundation Stage)

A Specialist Leader of Education (SLE) acts as a specialist 'peer' within their own area of expertise. As an SLE you would be involved in providing EY guidance and support, either directly to Schools/Settings or via our Early Years Aspiration Networks.

What would this involve?

Following an application and interview process, if appointed to the role of SLE, you would then be asked to provide your specialist input for those seeking guidance in early education in the foundation stage. The frequency of the work would be subject to demand and would be agreed by your Headteacher. *To remain designated you would need to complete at least 1 piece of work within 2 academic years.* Successful applicants will receive training to support the role.

Is this a paid position?

The role is not salaried but WEYH would cover the cost of your time out of school, i.e. cover costs, by paying your School a daily national rate.
