## Become a Specialist Leader of Education

A Specialist Leader of Education (SLE) is a national designation for those acting as specialist 'peers' within their own area of expertise. As an SLE you would be involved in providing guidance and support, whether that be direct support in schools/settings or providing input into (and delivering) support packages and/or training to help others develop in a particular area, such as meeting the requirements of the new EYFS. As an EY Teaching School, Warwickshire Teaching School Alliance (WTSA) is able to designate, train and support SLEs in Early Education.

### What would this involve?

Following an application and interview process, if appointed to the role of SLE, you would then be asked to provide your specialist input for those seeking guidance in early education in the foundation stage, or work alongside the WTSA to develop packages of support. The frequency of the work would be subject to demand and would be agreed by your Headteacher. To remain designated you would need to complete at least 1 piece of work within 2 academic years. Successful applicants will receive training specific to the SLE role.

### Is this a paid position?

The role is a national designation and is not salaried, but WTSA would cover the cost of your time out of school, i.e. cover costs, by paying your School a daily national rate.
